

Staggered Resumption for First Term 2021 – 2022 at LSR SSS [Document 1]

1. School will start at 08 00 hours and end at 14 15 hours
2. Students will be attending classes at school as from 5 July 2021 as follows:

(i) For LSR SSS

Grades 9, 9+(EP), 11 and 13 (Grades taking National Assessments and International Examinations – Monday, Wednesday and Friday)

Grades 7, 7EP, 8, 8EP, 9EP, 10 and 12 (Grades taking Internal Assessments / Examinations – Tuesday and Thursday)

3. The staggered resumption time table is over a period of two weeks for all grades.
4. Within each Grade, teaching groups will be split to ensure social distancing.
5. The school time table has been reworked as follows:
 - (i) School will start at 08 00 hours and end at 14 15 hours with 4 slots of learning time per day.
 - (ii) There will be 4 slots of learning time per day.
 - (iii) Each slot will of 1 hour 15 minutes' duration on a daily basis.
 - (iv) There will be a total of 5 hours of teaching per day.
 - (v) There will be two short breaks of 15 minutes and a lunch break of 30 minutes. Five minutes just after lunch break will be used for afternoon register by Form Teachers.
 - (vi) The daily time table will be scheduled as follows:

6. Activity periods, Library, Life skills, Social & Emotional Wellbeing, and Performing Arts classes are not included in the 4 learning slots for Regular Programme students. Schools should devise alternative modes for conducting these activities and addressing the non-core subjects.

(i) Students will be sent to Library when Educators are absent whenever possible.

(ii) Form teachers of Grades 7 to 9 Regular Programme need to request students to keep 3 small copy books (20 pages) for Life Skills, Social & Emotional Wellbeing and Performing Arts in their bags, to be used by Educators teaching these subjects when they are replacing other absent Educators/ their colleagues. Educators teaching Life Skills, Social & Emotional wellbeing and Performing Arts need to record these in their weekly plan and submit a weekly report to the Rector on every Monday morning on teaching carried out with students of classes which they met the previous week.
