


4. The examination fees should be **CREDITED TO THE ACCOUNT OF THE MES**, Account No. **61010100001723**, State Bank Ltd, Réduit. Payment will **not** be accepted at the MES.
5. The **original** (*not photostat copies*) bank deposit voucher/s (representing payment from candidates) should be submitted to the Mauritius Examinations Syndicate. The vouchers should bear the name of the candidate and the name of the school.
6. A **Responsible Officer** should be delegated to submit the bank voucher/s and the **hard copy of the Form EN2** (not handwritten) **duly signed** by the Head of School.
7. Kindly inform candidates who have been successful in previous DELF examination that “France Éducation International” has amended the regulation for resit candidates as follows:

“... un candidat peut se réinscrire pour la session d’examen suivante après la publication de ses résultats et ce, en cas d’échec comme en cas de réussite à l’examen.”

Successful candidates do not have to return their previous certificate if they choose to resit the examination.
8. Request for remarking/review of scripts will not be entertained.
